PINCH-HITTING: The best 9 are batting. Pinch hit late to offset any major shifts.

PINCH-RUNNING: Use Span when available to try and win late in the game (9th or later).

HIT & RUN: This will be our main priority this season. McCutchen, Reyes, Brantley, Span on base, ANY eligible hitter, score +/-2.

STEALS: Only straight steal in the 8th or later with the tying run. Reyes/Span are the options.

SACRIFICE: Cedeno/Giavotella will sacrifice with runners in scoring position, less than 2 outs, score -3/+2

BASERUNNING: **Master Game:** Use Adams Table. **Computer game:** Use your own judgment.

DEFENSIVE REPLACEMENTS: Span for Kubel, Turner for Alvarez with a lead after 8 innings.

OUTFIELD THROWS: I will trust your judgment here.

INFIELD: The infield will be back unless it is the 8th or later, there are less than 2 outs, and the tying/lead run is on 3rd base and there is no DP possibility.

HOLD: **Master Game:** Hold if runner has a 26+ chance. **Computer Game:** Always

STRETCH: Always **INTENTIONAL WALK:** Only to set up a DP in the 9th or later with a weaker hitter on deck and the game score +/- 1.

STARTING PITCHING: This is a VAST improvement over last season. The starters still pitch until they are fatigued. If the game is close then move to the quality relievers quickly. If we are getting blown out they stay and then go the mop up crew.

RELIEF PITCHING: This is the “strength” of the club this season. Use them to protect leads but don’t leave the top three in to take a beating.

Closer (9th inning on): Stammen has the responsibility for the season. In a 1 run game he can start the 8th. If he blows a lead he finishes the inning.

Late Relief (7th inning on): Morales/Brach will do their best to hold onto leads/ties in this role. If we fall behind by more than 2 runs they are to be pulled before the next batter.

Middle Relief (5th-7th innings): Hughes/Kelley are in this role. They can go 2 innings if necessary.

Mop-up Crew: This spot will be filled by Dunn/Rodriguez. They can go 2.2 innings per outing.



In 2013 we are regrouping while it is the pitching staff that tries to get healthy. The hope is that the offense will stay healthy and the pitching staff will mature to make for a fun 2014.
