Pitching Strategies

Starters: As usual, never remove a starter pitching a shutout and never let a starter pitch more than 11.7 innings. If the starter gets pounded out, spread the pain around the bullpen. Otherwise, here are the general guidelines:

Hudson: He should reach his fatigue limit in every start, even if you tag him with a 5 point downgrade early in the game. In a tight game, (+2 to -2) remove him when fatigued, If the Jets are ahead by 3 or more, he can pitch through two fatigue reductions.

Arroyo, Anderson and Wandy: We'd like to see them reach their fatigue limits, but if downgraded before then and the game is within reach (down 3 or less), then look to the pen. If down by 4 or more, keep them in the game and if it gets within three then get the bullpen warmed up.

Slowey, Leake, and Bergesen: If they make it to the 6th without being downgraded and the game is +/- 3, go to the pen. If the margin is more than three either way, they stay on the mound. If it tightens up later on, go to the pen.

Relievers: A strange bullpen. One big grade with nice peripherals, lots of interchangeable middle relievers and no real mop-up guy. O'Day is the closer and should start the 9th in save situations. He'll be set-up in the 7th and 8th by Loe, Cordero, and Robertson. Use them as you see fit. It'll be important to take advantage of the +5 on the boards. Some combination of Choate, Hughes, Atchison, Sonnanstine will make up the back of the pen and are available before the 7th or later if we're behind.

Defensive Strategies

Holding runners on 1st: Never hold if score is +5/-5. Otherwise, always hold with two out or with PL at bat. If less than two out and SA or PR at bat, hold if base SSN is greater than 18 and the runner has steal attempts remaining.

Play infield in: Play in 8th inning or later if the Jets are behind by less than two or up one.

Outfield Throws: Always throw for go-ahead run 8th inning or later. Board Game -Throw for lead runner with less than 33/36 chances, otherwise throw to hold trailing runners. Computer game- always throw for slow lead runner, throw for average and fast lead runners unless "well around", otherwise throw to hold trailing runners.

Defensive replacements: If we lead after we hit in the 9th, put Uribe at 3rd and Hairston at SS.

Offensive Strategies (in order of preference)

Steal: Gardner, Zobrist and Sean Rodriguez are the main threats. They have the green light to attempt steals of second from the 3rd inning on in games that are within 2 runs either way. If your catcher has a negative arm, they can attempt steals of third as the tying/lead run with 1 out 8th inning or later.

Hit and Run: Not a lot of H&R potential on this year's team. We'll be looking to H&R with our lineup vs LHP when legal with runners and hitters who are designated in the lineups above. Do not hit and run if your pitcher's control is worse than -26 on the board game or has a W on the computer.

Sacrifice: 8th or 9th place hitter at bat, 7th inning or later, tied or behind by one run, no outs, runners on second, or first and second. Don't squeeze.

Runner Advancement: Board Game- check Adams Tables. Computer Game- try for the extra base when "well around".

Pinch hitting: Unless specified in the monthly updates, let everyone play through their shifts.

Pinch running: Pick the fastest guy off the bench to run for Carlos "El Caballo Grande" Lee if he's the tying/lead run 7th inning or later. Pinch run for Branyan or Buck as the winning run 9th inning or later. Get the best defense afterwards.
