OFFENSIVE STRATEGIES

Hit and Run

Preferred over straight steal.

With runner on 1st & 3rd, H & R with 0 outs only.

- **Batters:** Bartlett, Crawford, Denorfia, Diaz, Doumit, Morse, Phillips, Sweeney.
- **Base-runners:** Bartlett, Colvin, Crawford, Denorfia, Diaz, McDonald, Moreland, Phillips

Stealing (2nd base only)

- **Crawford** after 5th, score +/-3 runs, adjusted SSN 28+, any # or outs.
- **Phillips, Bartlett & Denorfia** 7th or later score tied, SSN 27+
- **Colvin** 9th or later, 0 outs, SSN 29+

Sacrifice

Bartlett and rare cases **Crawford** (when batting 7th or 8th & facing LHP), 0 or 1 out, H & R not an option, 6th or later, tied or behind by 1.

Pinch-Hitting

When behind by 3 or less, after 6th. In blowouts for **Sweeney** after 5th.

- **vs. RHP:** **Burrell, Denorfia, Moreland** (when active)
- **vs. LHP:** **Denorfia, McDonald** (part of double switch), **Diaz** (when active), **Burrell, Morse** (as absolute last resort)

Pinch-Running

For any slow (<9 spd) runner, 8th or later, tie or winning run on, less than 2 outs

DEFENSIVE STRATEGIES

Outfield Throws

Always throw for lead runner if chances are <32, trailing runner if chances are <20, unless lead runner is tie or go ahead, 7th or later.

Hold Runner on First

Hold all runners regardless of speed.

Play Infield In

Deep at all times except:

- 3rd or 2nd & 3rd, <2 outs, 8th or later, tie or winning run.
- Bases full, 0 outs, 8th or later, tie or winning run

Intentional Walk

To face a weaker hitter & set up a DP possibility. Judgement call.

Pitch From the Stretch

Never unless runner has adjusted SSN to steal home is 15+, score +/- 1

Defensive Replacements

If we lead by 3 or less after 7th.

- McDonald at SS
- Denorfia or Diaz any OF-1
- Hayes at C, if base stealers due up

PITCHING STRATEGIES

Managing the Starters

Another good Dallas staff topped by a pair of 14's and anchored by a workhorse 8. With 7 relievers available most months, none of these starters should forfeit a lead after the 5th.

Johnson RHP and **CJ Wilson LHP**; the 14's at the top, very stingy on the HR but one with control issues. **Johnson** should pitch to fatigue, and beyond on the boards if we lead by 5 or more. Watch **Wilson** more closely not letting his negative control cost us a lead after the 5th.

Hunter RHP and **Richard LHP**; Pitch to fatigue, or into the 6th. Both can pitch past fatigue on the boards if we lead by 5 or more.

Haren RHP; lesser graded than in the past but has workhorse fatigue & good control. Attempt to get 5+ from him, but don't hesitate to get a **C** reliever in the 5th to prevent a big inning.

Coleman RHP, **Karstens RHP**; **Karstens** makes 3 starts in Nov, all at home. **Coleman** will make 8 starts early in the year, then disappear. If he can make it through 5 & game is close, pull him.

Using the Bullpen

A relief corps that should do well complementing the starting staff. 437 innings spread among 8 relievers, 214 of which is grade 14 or better. There are 2 areas that could be problematic: 1. Only 49 innings of 18+; 2. Absence of a true mop up or long range reliever. To counter that, we will have 7 arms available most months. Jeff Karstens (minors most of the year) is available should mop up innings be needed. We will begin the year with 7 in the pen, but that could change if starters perform better than anticipated.

Bailey (A), RHP: 49 innings, 1 inning closer. Period. If it's not a save situation, he should not be in there. Try to limit save attempts for when we are up 1 or 2 runs, unless the heart of your order is due to bat. He does not enter a tie game, and leaves if he allows a tie run to score. We will be as cautious with his innings as the A's currently are with his right elbow.

Bell (B), RHP: 70 innings; **Balfour (B)**, RHP 55 innings. The high end setup relievers. Multipurpose guys can stop rally in the 6th, or earn a save when we're up by 3 in the 9th. With Bell's +61 HR rating, he should be the one facing your long ball threats. Neither should be pitching if we're up by 5 or more.

Logan (B), LHP: 40 innings. **Graeme Lloyd** is back. The ultimate LOOGY. He's the guy working between **Bell** and **Balfour** and facing lefty hitters that won't be subbed for.

Hanrahan (B) RHP 70 innings. Entry level member of this group. Can come in when we're behind or ahead. Also can pitch through fatigue point on the boards to spare better graded relievers. Primary role is bridging to the higher graded relievers.

Jepsen (C) RHP: 59 innings. RH part of the group acting as early, or inning absorbing relievers. His good HR rating +51 also allow him to pitch in those close but high scoring games in the 3rd or 4th. Can pitch late in the game, if we have a 4+ run lead.

Feliciano (C) LHP: 63 innings, **Mijares (C)** LHP: 33 innings. Only **Feliciano** will be here all year. Use him as you would **Logan** only in earlier innings, or finishing out a game in which we have a large lead. The +61 against the HR may also find good use in later innings with men on & long ball threat at bat. May pitch beyond fatigue on the boards if we need to cover innings. **Mijares** remains on the inactive roster until **Logan** reaches his innings limit.

Coleman RHP, 8 innings, and **Karstens** RHP 58 innings (innocuous): Neither will see use as relievers before November unless someone runs short of innings.
